*On Virtual Reality we have a program in which students can practice their presentation skills. They experience a real VR audience, that responds to their presentation. Feedback can be given immediately or after the presentation.

**Chatbots is a 'robot' tool that can handle 25.000 questions immediately, gives answers, shows videos and links. It is an AI approach that enriches itself each time it is used.
